FUSES FOR TELETYPEWRITER APPARATUS

1. GENERAL

1.01 Fuses (that is, regular quick-blowing fuses without time-delay characteristics) are no longer generally recommended for teletypewriter apparatus. Teletypewriter apparatus should preferably be equipped with time-delay (also called time-lag) fuses. These time-delay fuses can be Fusetrons (manufactured by the Bussmann Co.), or Slo-Blo fuses (manufactured by the Littelfuse Co.). For proper Fusetron or Slo-Blo fuse ratings see P31.152. See P31.101 for fusing of rectifiers.
