1. GENERAL


- 1.01 This section outlines the method of installing the arrangement for tape feedout on No. 14 typing reperforators described on Drawing S-8771-143. The arrangement provides for feeding out the tape by means of "Blank" combinations and consists of an externally mounted push button wired to short circuit the relector magnet.
- 1.02 The parts required to add this device are as follows:
 - No. 146 Edwards push button block with 6-foot cord for 1 button (walnut finish)
 - No. 2956 Bryant receptacle
 - 1 No. 2958 Bryant plug
 - 1 12F Connection block

Brown or black lamp cord as required

1.03 The arrangement shall be installed and wired as shown in Figure 1.
